

- b. Remove and retain fan controller No 2, Mk 1 (FV 546143) from hull interior r.h. wall, retaining fixing items.
- c. Remove and retain rheostat control knob (A 20757) from spindle of fan controller, discarding the two No 4 BA securing screws.
- d. See Fig 2: Drill hole through control knob at dimensions shown.
- e. Remove cover and rheostat (19555) from fan controller, retaining all fixing items.
- f. See Fig 3: Drill a 3/32 in. diameter hole through rheostat spindle at dimensions shown.
- g. Remove front cover plate (19557) from fan controller, retaining fixing items.
- h. See Fig 4: Counterbore existing 19/64 in. diameter hole of cover plate to 3/4 in. at dimensions shown.
- j. See Fig 5: Fit the two manufactured contact strips to rheostat (19555) as shown.
- k. Refit all items removed, in reverse order, using the 3/32 in. pin (5315-99-948-9621) to secure the knob to rheostat spindle.





Fig 1 - Contact strips, details






Fig 2 - Control knob, hole drilled




Fig 3 - Rheostat spindle - hole drilled




Fig 4 - Cover, counter boring




Fig 5 - Rheostat, contact strips fitted




Fig 1 - Fuel pipes - Assembly




Fig 1 - Cooking vessel - assembly




Fig 1 - Suction pipe assembly

Fig 1 - Drilling detail




Fig 2 - Wire locking detail




Fig 1 - Engine compartment sealing panels





Fig 1 - Wiring diagram






